UPDATE FROM RUTH HARRIS, COUNTY CHAIR

To Our TCGOP Members and Conservative Unaffiliated:

You may think the most important thing you can do for your country is to vote in the November general election. Yes, that is important. **But even MORE important is to vote in the March primaries.** That is where we select the best candidate to go up against the opposition in November and, if they win, we are "married" to that person for a long time. In the case of the Senate race it is six years! If we choose the wrong person, that's a long time to live with our decision. In the past, we have had only about 20% turnout for the primaries. We want to change that in 2022. In 2022, we elect a new sheriff, a new US Senator, new NC Supreme Court judges, and many more!

In the past, you may have failed to vote in the primary because you didn't know enough about the candidates. There are so many! You feel overwhelmed. Since the GOP cannot endorse a particular candidate, it does require some research. We want to help you with that this year. In fact, we want to make it fun! We want you to find those candidates you can get behind. They become your horse in that race. Think of it like the sports team you root for in college football. It will make the general election all the more interesting because you know who the candidates are and you have a favorite!

We will be having individual candidate events at our **NEW HEADQUARTERS at 470 Asheville Hwy, Suite G** (next to "Love That Yogurt!" on the college-facing side of the building). In addition, on the evening of February 19th, during early voting, we will bring as many candidates as possible to the Rogow Room at the library. We want to give you as much opportunity as possible to meet and get to know all these candidates.

Legislative Redistricting News

With every 10-year federal census there is a realignment of legislative representation based on population changes. The good news is that North Carolina has gained another seat in the US House of

Representatives. The North Carolina General Assembly enacted this redistricting on November 3, 2021. We now belong to three new districts: NC Senate, NC House, and US House.

- NC State Senator – See the “S.L. 2021-173 Senate” map for the new district. The March 8, 2022, GOP primary election will determine our November General Election candidate. We will provide you with candidate information after the filing period closes on December 17th.
- NC State House Representative - See the “S.L. 2021-175 House” map for the new district. The March 8, 2022, GOP primary election will determine our November General Election candidate. We will provide you with candidate information after the filing period closes on December 17th.
- US House of Representative - See the “S.L. 2021-174 Congress” map for the new district. The March 8, 2022, GOP primary election will determine our November General Election candidate. We will provide you with candidate information after the filing period closes on December 17th.

2022 Republican Primary Elections – March 8, 2022

The party primary elections historically have low voter turnouts. Everybody watching what is happening to our country will agree that we need to have our best America First candidates in the November 2022 General Election. We will continue to update you on candidate information after the filing period closes on December 17th. Here are some key GOP primary elections that will be held March 8, 2022.

- NC State Senator – (see above)
- NC State House Representative (see above)
- US House of Representatives, District 14 (see above)
- US Senate (Richard Burr is retiring)
- NC Supreme Court
 - Democrats currently have a 4-3 majority. We have a chance to take a 5-2 majority on this court.
 - The NC Voter ID law is working its way up to the NC Supreme Court.

- Two Democrat Supreme Court justices are up for re-election in November 2022: Sam Ervin and Robin Hudson.
 - We have three candidates for these two positions: Trey Allen, Richard Dietz, April Wood.
 - Allen and Wood will likely compete in the March primary.
 - Transylvania County Board of Commissioners
 - Two seats are on the 2022 ballot
 - David Guice (UNA) is retiring.
 - Incumbent Jake Dalton (R) is running for re-election.
 - The March primary will determine the Republican candidates to fill these seats.
 - Transylvania County Board of Education
 - Two seats are on the 2022 ballot: Marty Griffin (D) and Courtney Domekur (R).
 - Griffin is running for re-election
 - Domekur will not seek re-election
